She has taught a variety of art classes in drawing, painting and clay work to students of all ages. Alisha is a Drumheller native and is excited to share her passion of visual arts with other artists in the valley.

## **Drawing 101** **\$120**

Have you ever wanted to learn how to draw? Would you like to learn how to portray our 3-dimensional world in 2-D? This course introduces the fundamentals of drawing. We will explore different exercises that will assist in basic drawing practices. This course is welcomed to beginner artists as well as those with more experience who would like to practice their drawing skills.

**Lesson 1:** Lecture: What is art? Visual representation with intention! Observational Drawing: "Drawing is seeing." Instead of looking down at your paper, you are to look up at the subject. Take note of angle, comparison and negative space, investigate blind contour. Class will try the techniques demonstrated and discussed.

**Lesson 2:** Line Drawing: flower still-life using pencil crayons (yellow-highlight, red-medium, blue-shadow). Techniques include hatching, cross-hatching, pointillism and tonality. Gestural drawing may be introduced. Class will try the techniques demonstrated.

**Lesson 3:** MODEL. Gestural drawings are technically stick figures used to map out the angles and weight of the figure. This will be demonstrated and practiced, using students acting as models for the others.

**Lesson 4:** MODEL. Figure drawing/gestural drawings will be continued, using different hands, not looking at the page, mapping the figure as fast as you can. The model will do shorter poses.







## Introduction to Vibrational Healing







## Drumheller Men's Group

This 30 hour program is part of a provincial network on Family Violence Treatment. Alberta Health Services Addiction and Mental Health offers group and individual counselling for the Drumheller, Hanna and Three Hills areas. There is no charge for this program and sessions are in the spring and fall of each year. Contact information is at the bottom of the page.

Group is Thursday evenings at the Drumheller Health Centre – Addiction and Mental Health Wing.

Referral agents, your clients will be interviewed by the program facilitators.

This 15 week open group invites men to explore healthy strategies to move towards the relationships they prefer. The focus is on moving from abusive behavior to respectful and accountable interactions. The group is confidential and

requires that participants complete a pre-program interview. The program is group focused and experiential. Individual counselling is offered when group programs are unavailable.

The remaining sessions introduce participants to skills that can help with clear and respectful communication. Participants will explore alternate ways of managing conflict, coping with stress, dealing with jealousy, setting boundaries, understanding anger, and the role alcohol and drugs play in relationship health. Other key elements in the program are developing empathy and learning to be accountable for one's words and actions.
