Standard First Aid Level C with AED

This comprehensive first aid course will provide participants with fundamental skills and knowledge that will assist you in any emergency situation. Course includes adult CPR, choking, artificial respiration, bleeding and fractures. This course is a must for those working with children, students or the elderly. This is the certificate course that is required for employment purposes. AED training (defibrillator) included in course. Certificate awarded upon completion.

This is a blended course. Participants will need to complete an online portion of training prior to the one day on-site skills training. Once the online portion is completed, students will print a badge to bring to the skills practice. Instructions will be given upon registration.

This 1-day recertification is a challenge of the St. John's Ambulance's Standard First Aid course content and requires the student to demonstrate essential skills as well as pass the theoretical exam. The recertification is intended for those who are able to demonstrate their competency in all required skill areas. Upon successful completion of the practical skills evaluation and written exam, a Standard First Aid Certificate will be issued. The Certificate is valid for three (3) years. Recertification is NOW available every 3 years.

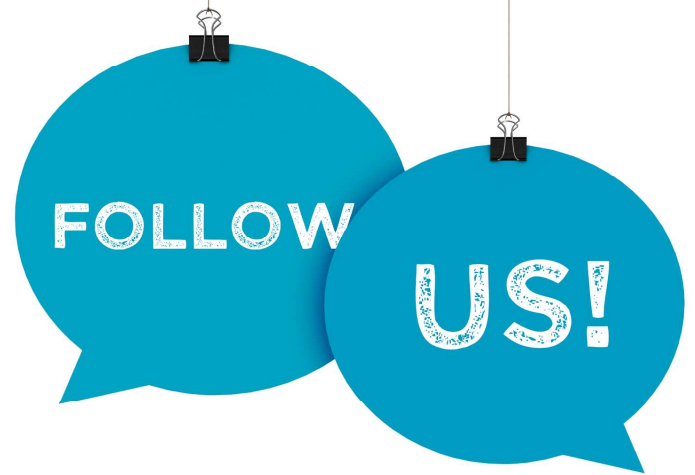

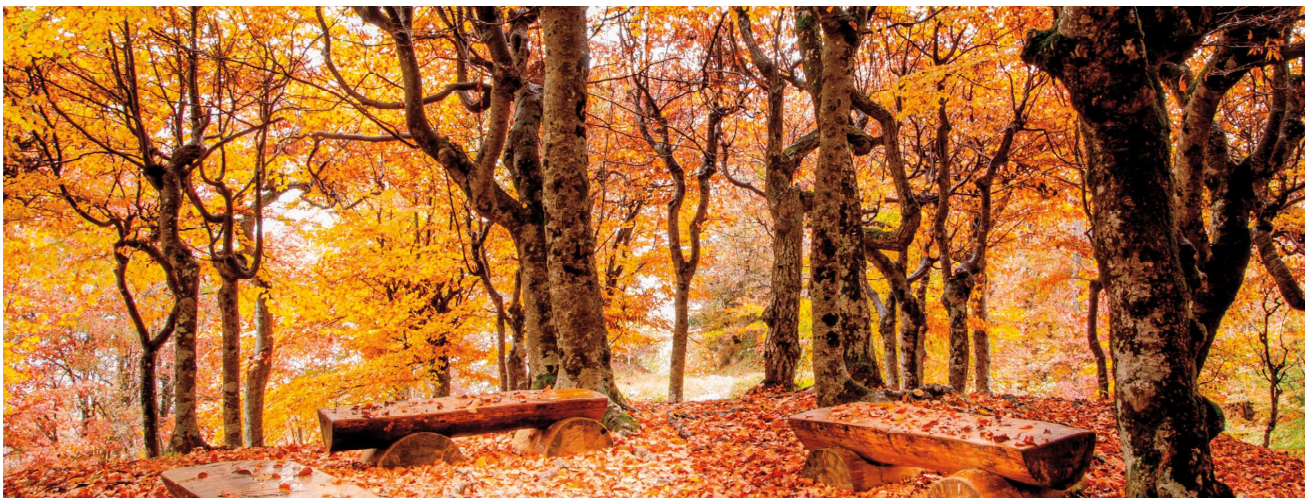
